

## **Top Tips for Remote Filming**

Here are some hints and tips to help you get the best results when filming remotely through the Virtual Studio.

- Prepare in advance last minute actions often create long term problems.
- This good to have a solid internet connection. A hard-wired computer is best but if you don't have that, be as close to the wireless router as you can.
- of If possible, please wear headphones to ensure the highest possible audio quality. Earbuds are best and less visible. If you don't have headphones that's fine as your device's microphone will suffice.
- Ensure that the camera lens on your device is clean, a quick wipe with a cloth can work wonders.
- Try to set up a light in front of your face (maybe behind your computer or off to the side).
- Choose a background you feel comfortable with and make sure there is nothing sensitive in view. If you have windows directly behind you, you will need more light in front of you to balance it out.
- We recommended business casual clothing but you should select whatever you feel is most appropriate.
